## **Policy Reminders**

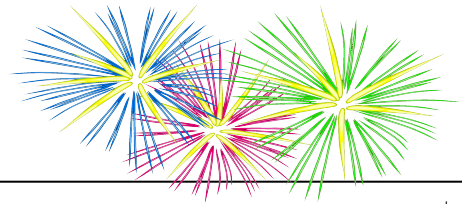
